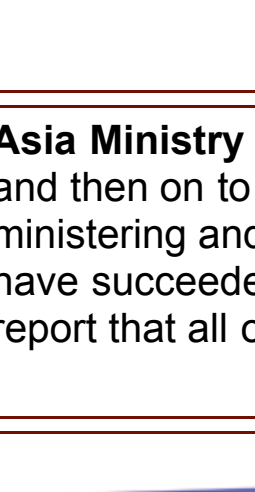

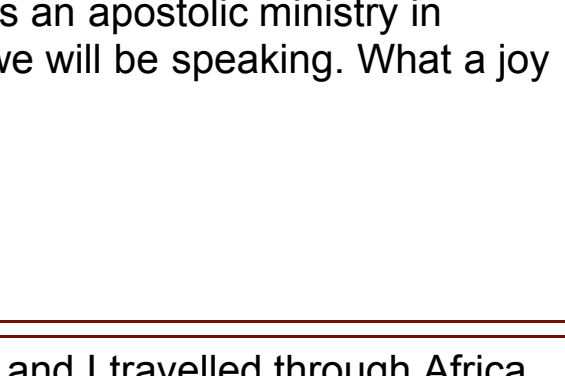
Celebration 2011

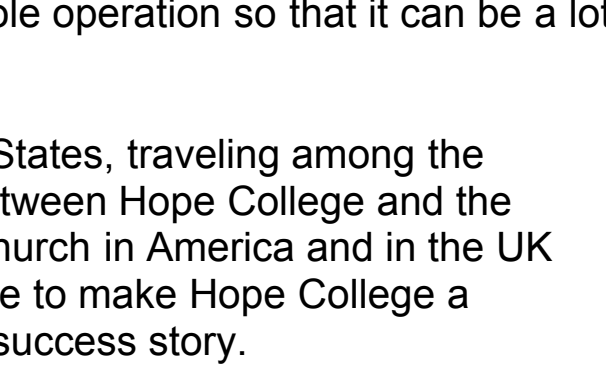
AWARENESS SUNDAY A PATH TO PEACE

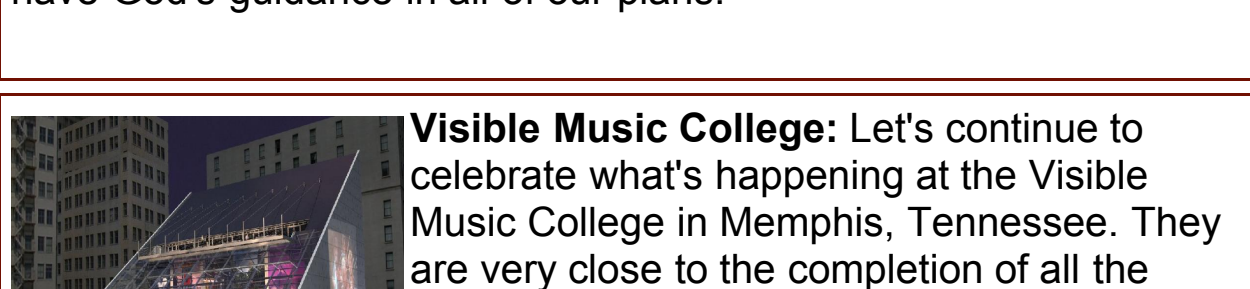

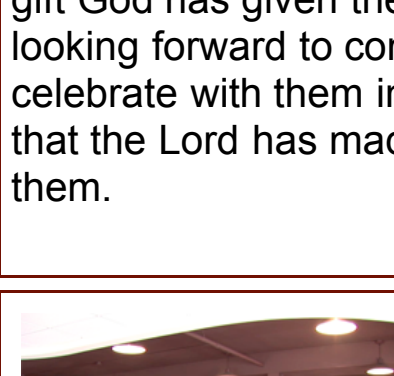

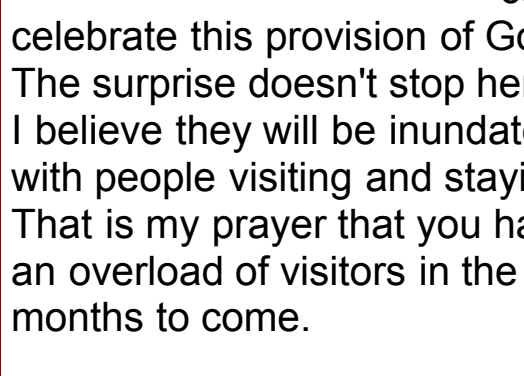

Keep us in prayer as we adjust to these changes and continue to have God's guidance in all of our plans.

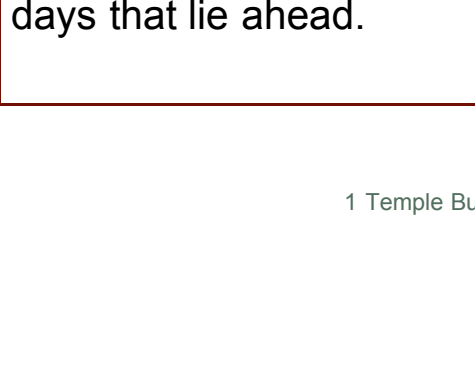
